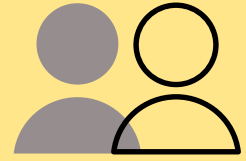

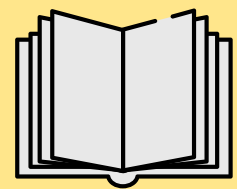
2020 ACCOMPLISHMENTS

125 Members from **65** agencies and **13+** sectors; including child care and early learning, early intervention, family support, faith communities, mental health, health care, and government



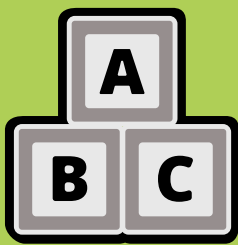
More than **4,000** resource guides printed and distributed

Early childhood mental health kits provided to **36** members to assist with social emotional learning for young children in the classroom



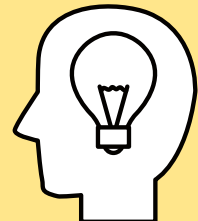
2 Learning Through Play events attended by more than **90** people
